EAGLE DAY CAMP FAQ

WHAT IS EAGLE DAY CAMP?

Eagle Day Camp is a full or half day camp for students ages 4 to 12 years old that takes place on the LCCS campus. Each week will have a different fun theme filled with age-appropriate activities and games. (See Eagle Day Camp weekly schedule and dates)

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN FULL DAY AND HALF DAY?

- Full Day 8:30am to 4:30pm \$200
 - Choose which themed week(s) your student would like to attend. Drop off starts at 8:30am and the day ends at 4:30pm.
- Half Day 8:30am to 12:30pm OR 12:30pm to 4:30pm - \$100
 - Families can choose to register their student(s) to attend Eagle Day Camp for half the day; morning or afternoon.

CAN I ONLY SIGN UP FOR HALF DAY AT EAGLE DAY CAMP?

Yes! Select which half of the day works best for your family's schedule: AM or PM.

EAGLE DAY CAMP FAQ

CAN I MIX AND MATCH EAGLE DAY CAMP WITH OTHER LCCS CAMPS?

Yes! If your student is registered for another LCCS camp (art, science, sports, etc), you may choose a half day at Eagle Day Camp to complete a full day on campus.

- Example1: Johnny is attending football camp from 9:00-11:00am. His parents also signed him up for a half day of Eagle Day Camp in the afternoon. Each day that week at 11:00am, LCCS staff will walk Johnny from football camp over to Eagle Day Camp until his parents arrive by 4:30pm.
- Example 2: Michelle is attending chemistry camp from 1:00-3:30pm. Her parents also signed her up for a half day at Eagle Day Camp in the morning. Each day that week, Michelle is dropped off at Eagle Day Camp at 8:30am. After lunch, LCCS staff will take Michelle to chemistry camp by 1:00pm and her parents will pick her up at 3:30pm when chemistry camp ends.

WHAT IF MY STUDENT IS SIGNED UP FOR TWO LCCS CAMPS IN ONE WEEK?

If your child is registered for both a morning and afternoon camp, LCCS offers a supervised lunch and activities through Eagle Day Camp before heading to their next session – at no extra cost!

• Example3: Henry signed up for art camp in the morning and basketball camp in the afternoon. Henry will attend art from 9:00-11:30am but because basketball does not start until 1:00pm, Henry will join Eagle Day Camp during lunch time. He will be taken to his afternoon basketball camp where his parents will pick him up at 4:00pm.

LUNCH & SNACKS

Lunch is not provided. Campers staying for a full day of Eagle Day Camp or dropping in for supervised lunch must bring their own lunch. Students must also bring a leak-proof water bottle. A snack will be provided in the morning and in the afternoon (two snacks total for full day campers). Parents must indicate on the camp registration form any food allergies for their student.

WEEKLY EMAILS

You will receive an email the week before camp begins with specific Eagle Day Camp information including drop-off and pick-up information. If you are registered for multiple weeks, please be sure to read each weekly email as some information may change from week to week.
